 These are the journals of Jacob Creath, Jr., the "Iron Duke of the Restoration"

Reminiscences of the Restoration (W.D. Frazee) **\$8**
 These come from Frazee's *Reminiscences and Sermons*, published in 1893.

Heralds of Christian Unity (Thomas Hagger) **\$8**
 These are 19 biographical sketches of pioneers of the restoration movement, honoring leaders from places such as the British Isles and Australia.

The Haldane Brothers of Scotland
 (Robert Haldane and James Alexander Haldane) **\$17**
 This collection of the Haldane brothers' memoirs includes sketches of the progress of religion in Europe, particularly Scotland, in the former half of the 19th century.

Charles Holder, Pioneer Preacher in the Sequachie Valley
 (John Ancil Jenkins) **\$8**
 A poor preacher, Charles Holder dedicated his life to spreading the gospel during the American economic depression and began several congregations in the Sequachie Valley.

Recollections of Men of Faith (W.C. Rogers) **\$12**
 This collection contains conversations, incidents, and anecdotes of Restoration pioneers such as Alexander Campbell, John Rogers, and Jacob Creath, Jr.

Standing for Their Faith (William Woodson) **\$9**
 This book is a history of churches of Christ in Tennessee from 1900-1950.

• **INTERPRETATION OF SCRIPTURE** •

Principles of Bible Interpretation (Alexander Campbell) **\$5**
 Campbell, tired of extra-biblical doctrines and denominational creeds, penned this book in an effort to exemplify the principles of the Bible and the importance of using the Bible as one's sole creed.

Hearing God Speaking: A Study On Biblical Interpretation (Gary Hampton) **\$10**
 Hampton discusses the spiritual importance of comprehension and interpretation in Bible study.

Illuminating Shadows: Old Testament Images Used in the New Testament (Teresa Hampton) **\$9**
 This book shows the connection between Old Testament shadows and their fulfillment in the New Testament.

Out of the Shadows: NT Truths Presented by OT Shadows (John Kackelman) **\$12**
 Kackelman discusses the connections between New Testament principles and their Old Testament shadows, follows the scheme of redemption throughout the entirety of the Bible, and shows why the New Testament is a Christian's ultimate authority today.
